

Senior Welder

MAJOR JOB FUNCTIONS

To set-up, maintain, and perform moderately complex and difficult welding operations using standard or specialized welding techniques and accessory tools necessary for completion of assignment, under minimum supervision.

BASIC DUTIES

- Sets-up, maintains, and performs difficult welding operations within required tolerances, using standard or specialized techniques working from drawings, rough sketches, written specifications, and verbal instructions
- Employs all welding processes and equipment to accomplish attachment of various metal works with a wide variety of materials (aluminum, stainless, brass, and copper)
- Inspects own work using measuring equipment such as squares, surface gauges, and calipers
- Recognizes critical areas such as sealing surfaces and final finishes and uses proper care to prevent damage
- Performs other related duties as required

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

High School diploma or equivalent GED, trade school or equivalent, + minimum of five (5) years industrial welding experience preferred

Skilled in Tig welding. Techniques in Mig and Stick welding as well as Torch for attachment of various metals is a plus

Must be able to set up machine and read standard blueprints and have a knowledge of shop mathematics through geometry

Must have own toolbox and tools, and gauges necessary to perform assignments

Current or previous AWS certification a plus

Other duties and responsibilities:

- Will be cross-trained as back-up in other areas of the manufacturing plant which broadens skills
- Other job-related duties as may be necessary to carry out the responsibilities of this position

Work Relationships and Scope:

Reports directly to the Machine shop supervisor; daily interaction with other operations including plant production employees.

Working Conditions:

Work is done in A/C climate-controlled areas. This position works in a production environment with the risk of injury so safety equipment must be worn when working with equipment in the shop. Bending, lifting and pushing up to 70 pounds is required.

Excellent attendance is required. Our location is in East Dallas off I30 and Buckner Blvd Some overtime is possible, and some Saturday work will be requested on rare occasions Must successfully complete criminal background check and drug screen test Must be a citizen of the US, due to our customer's contract requirements
